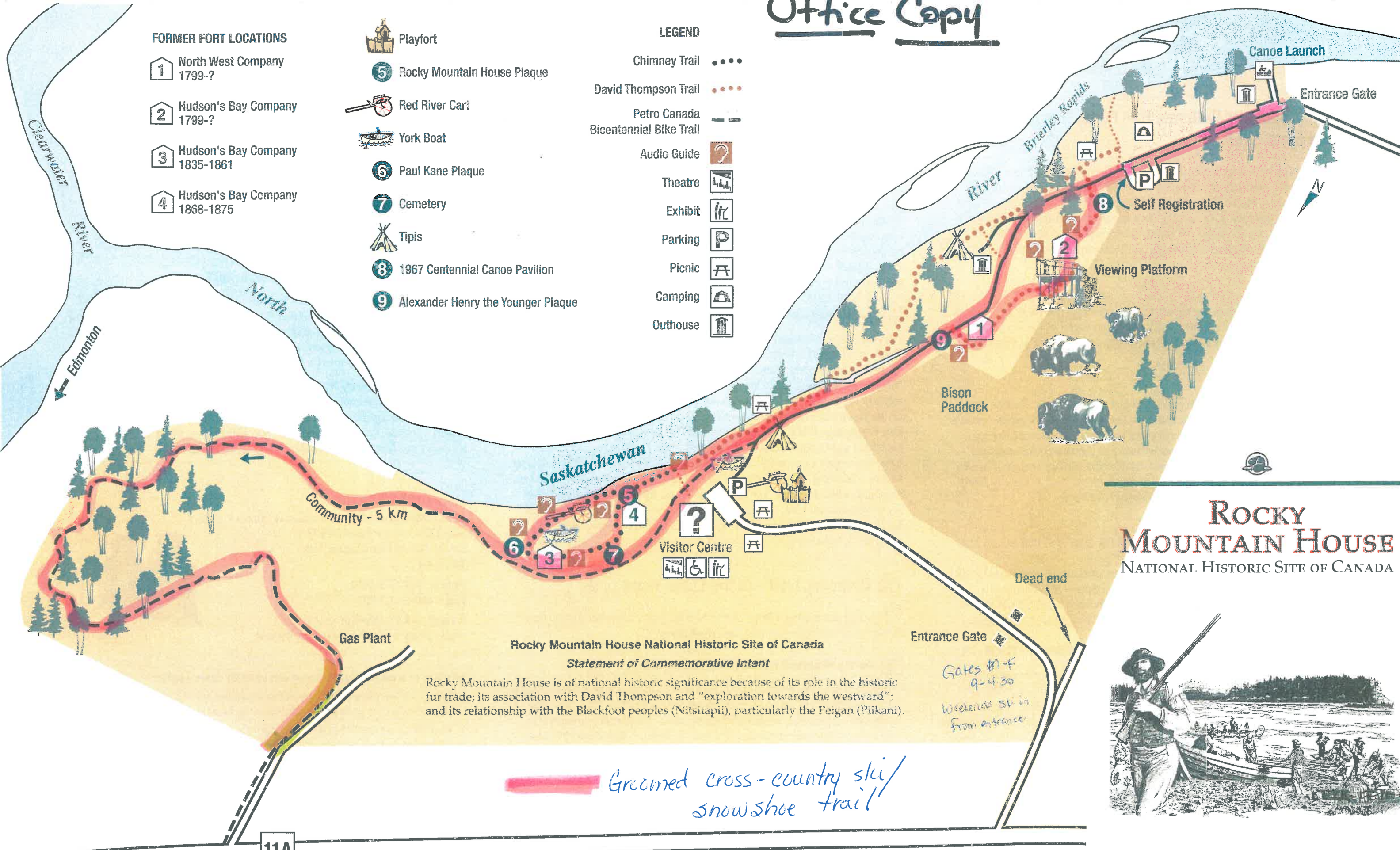

Statement of Commemorative Intent

Rocky Mountain House is of national historic significance because of its role in the historic fur trade; its association with David Thompson and "exploration towards the westward"; and its relationship with the Blackfoot peoples (Nitsitapii), particularly the Peigan (Pikani).
